

WHAT IS SVA?

Student Veterans of America (SVA) is a coalition of student veterans' organizations on college campuses across the United States, and is one of the most rapidly growing grassroots veterans organizations in the U.S. today. Since founding in January of 2008, SVA has expanded from 20 initial member groups to over 200 Chapters nationwide, with a network of more than 10,000 veterans.

OUR MISSION

SVA has **three** main mission points:

- Assist veterans in their successful transition to academia
- Develop programs and policies on campuses to aid in the reintegration of veterans
- Advocate on behalf of student veterans at the state and national level

SVA, through education, advocacy and service, is dedicated to creating an environment that fosters a smooth transition into institutions of higher learning from military service.

HOW IS SVA HELPING?

Student Veterans of America acts as a guiding hand, assisting in the development of student veterans' groups and campus resources for all of our nations' veterans.

Additionally, SVA has established a number of programs to assist in carrying out our mission. These programs include:

- A peer-to-peer suicide prevention and mental health program
- Wounded Injured and Ill Veterans Educational Transition Team (VETT) Program, connecting veterans in the military hospitals and Warrior Transition Units with local SVA chapters
- Connecting student veterans with employers and mentors in their respective fields
- Providing a chapter grant system to support chapter sponsored events

WHAT ARE SVA'S GOALS?

SVA has **four** primary short term goals:

- Increase student veteran graduation rates from institutions of higher learning by 15%
- Boost SVA peer support tools and resources by 25%
- Augment individual veteran usage of GI Bill benefits by 15%
- Enhance veteran enrollment rates at institutions of higher learning by 20%

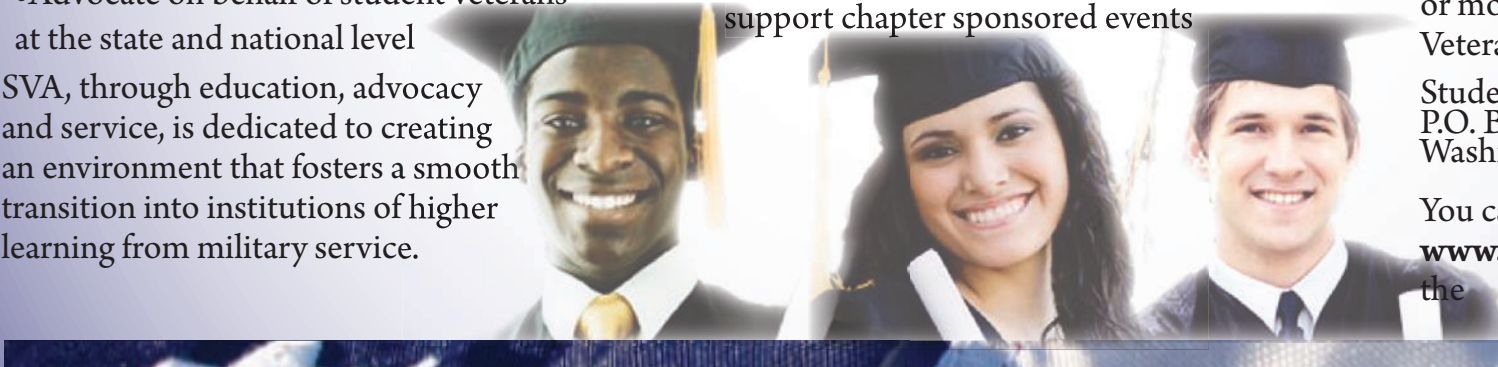

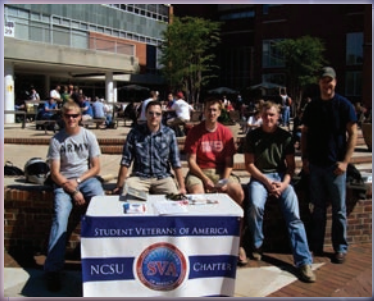
